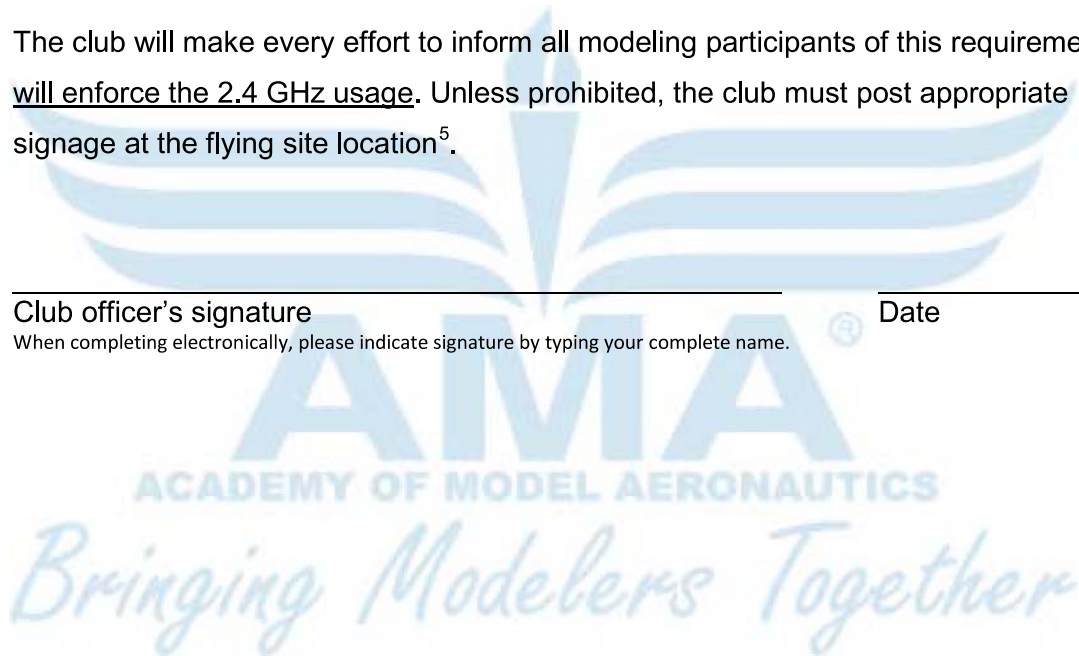

<sup>5</sup> Various signs stating "2.4 GHz use only" will be posted at the flying site, unless the property owner prohibits any postings. Signs must be prominently displayed at least at the field entrance, with the field rules and with the current Safety Code poster. Additional signage is recommended. The club may consider installing a generic frequency board with an additional "2.4 GHz use only" posting.
