The following was published in the April 1991 issue of Model Aviation magazine. Donald was a 1990 Charles Hampson Grant Scholarship winner.

Donald Slusarczyk, a native of Brecksville, Ohio, is studying aeronautical/aerospace engineering at Ohio State University. He received \$7,000 from the committee.

An Indoor modeler since age 12, Donald has set 50 national records in Junior and Senior Indoor categories. At 15, he was the youngest person to ever qualify for the FAI Indoor Team Selection Trials. Past achievements include winning the Sig Memorial Award and the Stout Commercial Award.

At Brecksville High School, Donald was named to the National Honor Society and was a member of the Drama Club and the Bowling Team. He also competed in the Ohio Test of Scholastic Achievement.

Donald is a member of the local Kiwanis group. He has demonstrated Indoor model flying to numerous science classes and has performed magic shows for the local elementary school.
