

## The AMA History Project Presents: Biography of DENNIS SUDING

The following was published in the April 1988 issue of Model Aviation magazine. Dennis was a 1987 AMA scholarship winner.

Dennis Suding graduated from Evergreen High School in Evergreen, Colorado. He has entered the University of Colorado in Boulder where he will major in Business and Computer Science. Dennis has been awarded a \$2,000 scholarship. His high school years saw him involved in a variety of scholastic and sports activities including the Spanish Club, Skiing Club, Golfing Team, Latin Honor Society, and computer programming.

Outside of school, he joined the Junior Achievement program, and enjoyed motorcycles and model aircraft. During his final two years of high school, Dennis taught religious education classes (CCD) to sixth grade children in his home parish.

He has constructed more than 20 airplanes in the past six years, and has honed his skills in Pattern flying. His current airplane is a *Hippo-Tipo*. As a member of Jefco Aeromodelers, he flies at Chatfield State Park Model Airport, one of the finest in the country. It should be noted that Dennis lived in the Washington D.C. area for several years, where he attended Herndon High School and flew with the Northern Virginia R/C Club.
