## AMA joins other UAS organizations in national safety campaign



AMA and other leading unmanned aircraft system (UAS) organizations launched a "Know Before You Fly" campaign in time for the holidays. AMA partnered with the Association for Unmanned Vehicle Systems International (AUVSI), the Small Unmanned Aerial Vehicle (UAV) Coalition, and the FAA in a national campaign to promote safe and responsible flying. The campaign provides prospective operators with the information and guidance they need before flying their small UAVs. The campaign addresses many issues including learning how to fly and who can fly.
